Since 1982, Coronado Schools Foundation has stood for academic excellence by making a difference in the lives of our public school children. With your help, we can continue this tradition.

Here is a sampling of the many programs and special projects our community has provided for students through the Foundation:

- ✦ \$3 million+ total contributions to Coronado's public schools
- ✦ Funding of a Technology Resource Teacher (TRT) (part-time) at Coronado High, Coronado Middle, and Silver Strand and Village Elementary Schools to ensure educational technology is harnessed for an optimal academic experience.
- ✦ \$27,500 special funding for science (2007); \$22,000 for libraries (2006), and a virtual library portal was launched for every student to use at home and school (www.cusdlibs.org).
- ✦ \$10,000 for music and arts initiatives (2007).
- ✦ \$30,000 annually for science, math and music.
- ✦ Annual Block Grant funding for program and department support resources:
 - Science, art and enrichment at Coronado High School.
 - Technology at Coronado Middle School.
 - Special enrichment programs at Silver Strand and Village Elementary.
