"The Academic Performance Index (API) scale ranges from 200 to 1000 with all districts and each school assigned a single number based on student performance on STAR tests. It rewards growth in moving students from below proficient performance to proficient and advanced performance. The State set a score of 800 as the target, which indicates a school is high performing. Schools scoring over 900 are considered well above average and in the top 10% of schools throughout the State. In 2011, 54% of San Diego County schools are at 800 or above. Coronado Unified School District's (CUSD) API continues to improve as shown by our continual growth, evidenced by its highest API score ever, 896. We maintain the rank of highest performing K-12 unified school district in San Diego County. CUSD teachers, parents, and administrators continue to analyze these results as well as other local measures and use our Strategic Planning process to ensure we are providing a rich and rigorous educational program that will allow our students to reach their full academic potential. Through CSF's broad financial support-- for technology and classroom resources, academic support teachers, enrichment teachers and programs, science lab and technology resource teachers, and professional development time, and more -- virtually all parts of our preschool-grade 12 academic program are touched by the Coronado Schools Foundation.
