
Dear Friends,

Our Coronado public school students continue to thrive and excel with the exceptional learning opportunities provided in our four local schools. Thanks to your generosity, over \$800,000 was returned through the Coronado Schools Foundation for the 2017-18 school year.

The funding Coronado Unified School District receives from the state is simply not enough to fuel and expand pathways in science, technology, engineering, arts and mathematics – STEAM. Our district receives \$1,900 less per student than San Diego Unified, simply due to our demographics. While over 35% of our students are military dependents, we do not have enough students who qualify for free and reduced lunch, are English-language learners, homeless and foster youth. Coronado Unified is funded 36th out of 42 school districts in Southern California.

Our Board of Directors and dedicated staff are in the second year of a three-year strategic plan with a goal to increase community engagement, resulting in an annual investment in our schools of \$1M by the 2019-20 school year. That's where you can help. As a resident, business owner or parent or grandparent of a Coronado Unified student, we are confident you stand with us, here to protect and fund programs that fuel and nurture our children's desire to learn and dream. # Public Schools: Why Private Dollars?

CALIFORNIA PUBLIC EDUCATION FUNDING IS COMPLICATED AND INADEQUATE. WHY? THERE ARE FOUR MAIN FACTORS:

## State Funding For Education In California Is Inadequate

**California ranks 46th in the nation in school funding.** With the recent changes in how funding is allocated to California school districts, which allocates funding dependent on student demographics, districts like Coronado are ranked 50th in the nation in school funding. While states like New York and New Jersey average \$20,000 per student, Coronado Unified receives about \$8,200 per student.

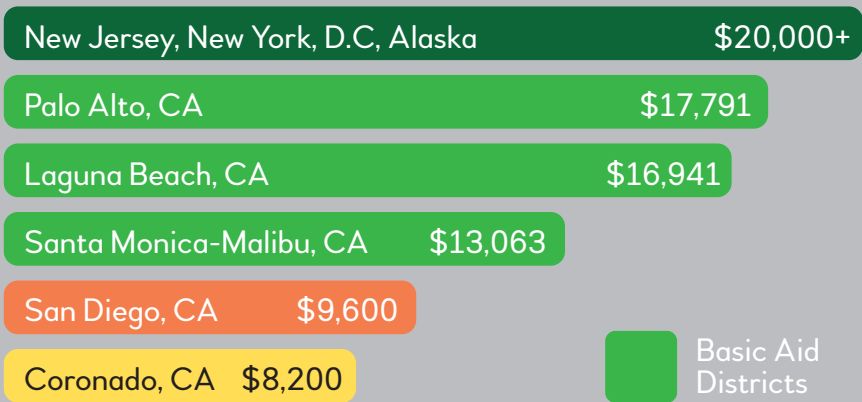
While it's true that California school districts have seen the biggest increase in funding in recent years, these increases only serve to restore buying power to 2007 levels, before the Great Recession.

## Coronado Unified Is A Local Control Funding Formula District

**While Coronado's property taxes are high, only a small portion funds education.** Because of Redevelopment Agency related laws from the 1980s, a majority of property tax revenues are being diverted to the State, rather than to CUSD. As a result, CUSD is an LCFF district and does not retain excess property taxes - approximately \$1 to \$3 million dollars of ongoing monies that benefit the State of California, rather than local schools.

"Basic Aid" districts like Palo Alto Unified, Laguna Beach Unified and Santa Monica-Malibu Unified receive little state funding because their revenue from local property taxes exceeds what they would receive from the Local Controlled Funding Formula - see below.

### 2016-17 Per Student Funding



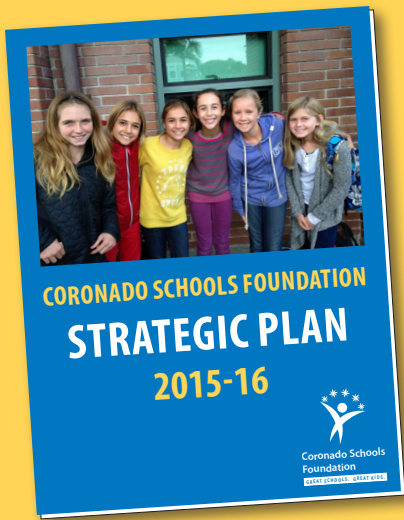
## Our Students Do Not Qualify For Supplemental Funding

In 2013, California legislature implemented the Local Control Funding Formula (LCFF) to provide additional resources to public school districts with higher numbers of students who qualify for free or reduced lunches, are English language learners, foster or homeless students. **This reality places CUSD's per student funding as 36th out of 42 school districts in San Diego.**

## Coronado Unified Does Not Have A Parcel Tax

Unlike many highly ranked districts in California, CUSD does not have a parcel tax to supplement state funding or our schools. CUSD was unsuccessful in 2014 when Proposition E was placed on the ballot.

Despite these significant funding challenges, Coronado Unified is frequently compared to a short list of school districts in California that have strong student outcomes. CSF is the ONLY district-wide resource that funds teachers and fuels STEAM pathways/enrichment. **YOUR support of CSF is critical to maintain the quality of our public schools.**



# Strategic Planning, Year 2: Increase in Donor Engagement

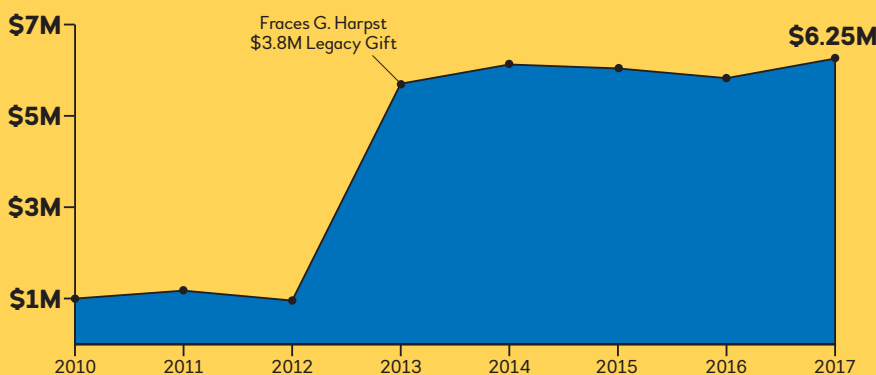
Coronado Schools Foundation Board of Directors has completed year one of the three-year Strategic Plan approved in May of 2016. Developed under the facilitated guidance of a consultant with full Board and staff participation as well as focus groups, five priority area teams were created – governance, program, marketing, financial stewardship, and fundraising. These teams are collectively working towards an over-reaching goal to increase the financial return to the schools to \$1,000,000 by the 2019-20 school year. ## Your Donations Fuel Imaginations

When CSF was incorporated by caring parents and community members in 1982, the annual return to the schools was a few thousand dollars, very important to the Coronado Unified classrooms. As depicted in the thermometer, increases over the years have been spurred by increased parent and community engagement, efficient event planning, fundraising, and administration oversight.

Since the 1990s, the CSF Board deposited 10% of the annual net income into an endowment fund which grew to nearly \$1,000,000 in 2010 when the Frances G. Harpst legacy gift of \$3,800,000 was received. This life-changing gift for our public schools has now grown to \$6,250,000 returning \$310,000 to our schools for this school year.

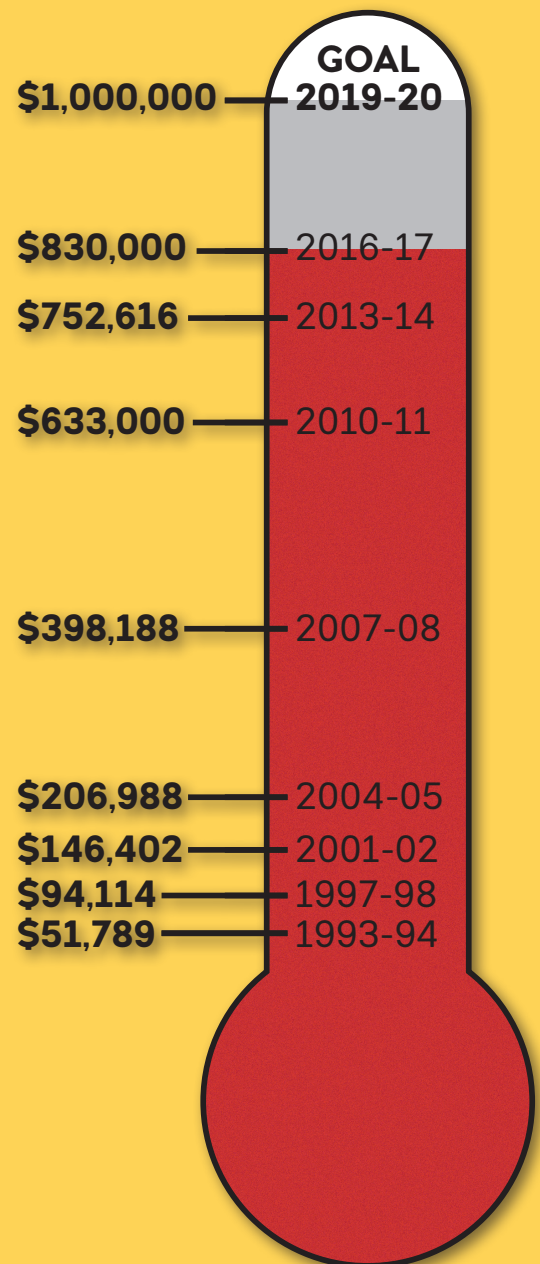
**Endowment End Of Year Balances**



## Endow the Future

Donations to the endowment provide both current year and perpetual benefits. A gift of \$25,000 provides a 4% return or \$1,000 annually while a \$250,000 donation provides \$10,000 in perpetual funding. The endowment is managed by the CSF Finance Committee with both Board and community members providing financial stewardship. With Coronado Unified funded 36th out of 42 school districts in Southern California, the need for ongoing perpetual funding is crucial to maintain academic excellence and provide programs that fuel imaginations.

## CSF Historical Financial Return



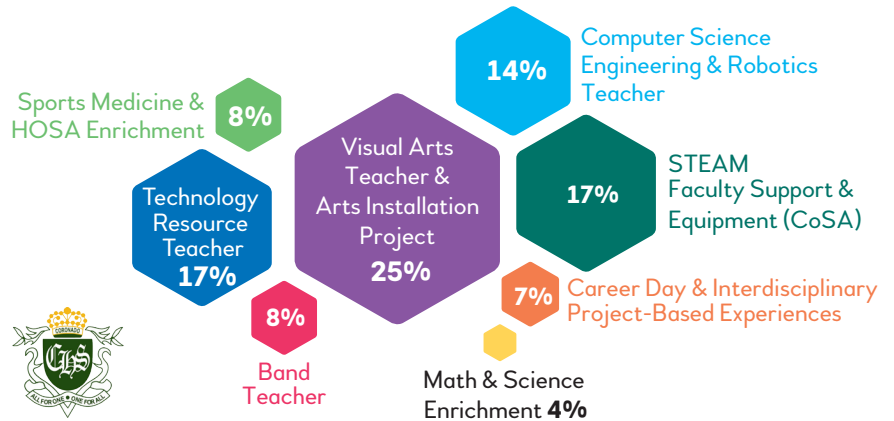

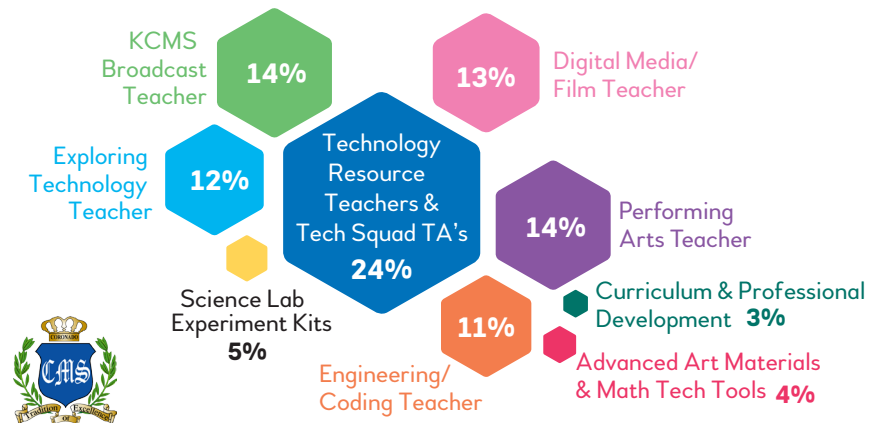
## Coronado High School

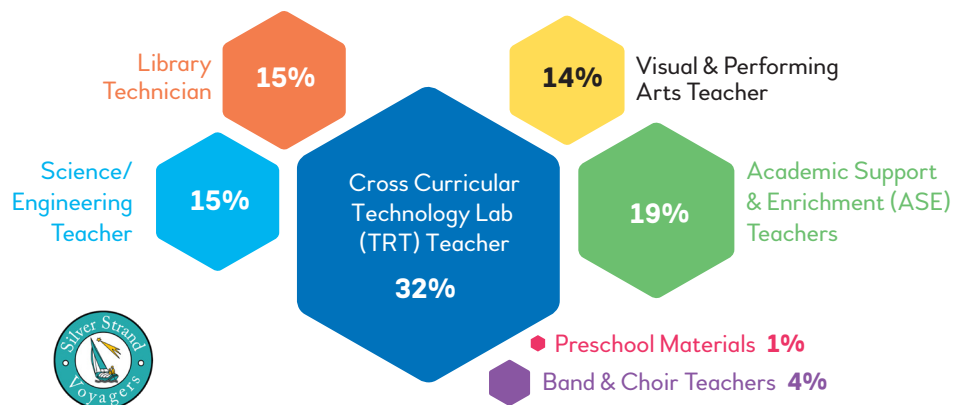
## Coronado Middle School

**\$172,381**



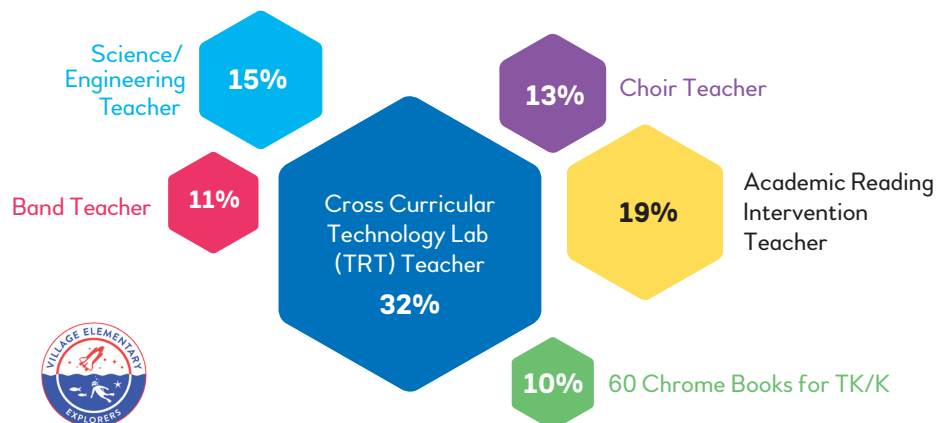
## Silver Strand Elementary School

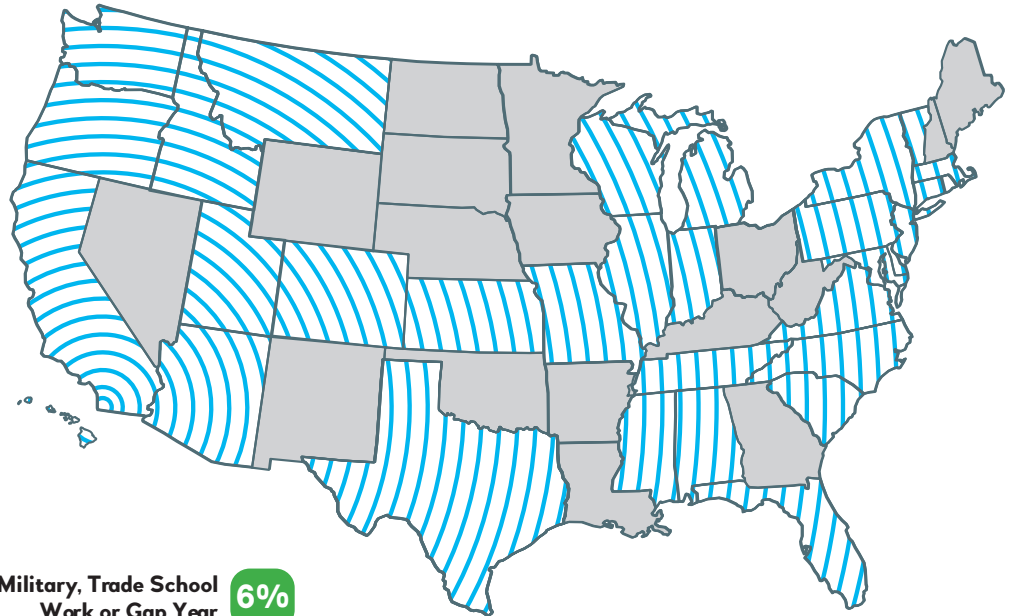

# Efficient Stewardship of Donor Funds

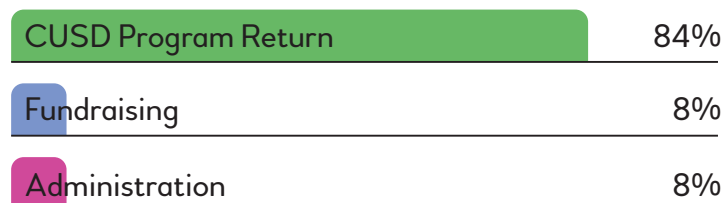
